## **CAA passenger safety charge to increase**

---

EFFECTIVE June 1, the Civil Aviation Authority passenger safety charge will increase from R10 to R11.

On tickets issued prior to May 5 for travel commencing on or before June 1 and for return travel on or after June 1, taxes to be levied will be the combination of the two applicable taxes.
